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EARRING AND BROOCH CONSTRUCTION

DYES  
SCARVES  
NATURAL SILKE  
YARNS

### Materials Needed:

1. #30, 36, 45 or 60 button shells and backs.
2. Patterns for sizing the button covers.
3. Wire cutters and scissors.
4. Scrap silk pieces.
5. Interfacing, thin (iron on pellon)
6. Button shell, button backs, earring stud and barrel lug clip-on or scarf clip.
7. Card to insert earring into.
8. Pin-back for #60 button shell.

### Procedure:

1. Remove the metal from the button back with wire cutters.
2. Cut the silk and interfacing one size larger than the button form, eg. #30 button shell, you use #36 pattern.
3. Place the silk face down then the interfacing and place into rubber button holder.
4. Insert the button on top of the silk and interfacing and tuck in the material in the hollow space at the back.
5. Place the button back on next and use metal pucher to be sure it is in properly.
6. Heat the glue-gun. Use a small amount of hot glue to fasten the stud to the earring.
7. Puncture holes in the card into which the earring set will be inserted. Do not use the stem of the stud to puncture the cardboard as it will damage the stud. Insert earring and place the lug at the back.

### PATTERNS FOR EARRINGS AND BROOCHS:
